The film opened in Japan just earlier this year on the Golden Week holidays.

The previous theatrical showing of the Conan series in China was in Spring of last year, with “The Raven Chaser,” in 500 theaters. With “The Raven” proving to be a big success and with the timing of the release going according to the schedule of the Chinese Government Distribution Department, this year’s showing has become a much bigger event.

The films were all new prints, with both Japanese subtitle and voice over version produced, and there will be both print screenings and digital screenings.

TMS, as a member of the theatrical Detective Conan Production Committee, is handling animation production as well as worldwide distribution. We have been working steadily to realize the same year theatrical release of the film in both China and Japan.
